The Dempster Dumpmaster System is a highly advanced method of refuse handling and disposal. It combines the best features of enclosed, containerized refuse storage with the advantages of high-density compaction and hauling.

One truck-mounted Dumpmaster serves many trash and waste accumulation points where the material is stored in containers in sizes ranging up to 8-cubic-yard capacity.

Making its rounds from location to location, the self-loading Dumpmaster picks up each container, empties the contents into its body, returns the container, then hydraulically crushes and compacts the loose material to a fraction of its former bulky volume.

This tight, dense compaction achieved by the internal hydraulic packer plate enables the Dumpmaster to carry the contents of many containers, many conventional truckloads, on each trip to the disposal area.

At the landfill or disposal site, the Dumpmaster hydraulically ejects its dense load and quickly returns to its collection route to empty more containers.

One man, the driver, handles the entire operation, collection, compaction and hauling. In this manner, one Dumpmaster and one man handle the refuse generation from many locations, disposing of hundreds of cubic yards of material every day.

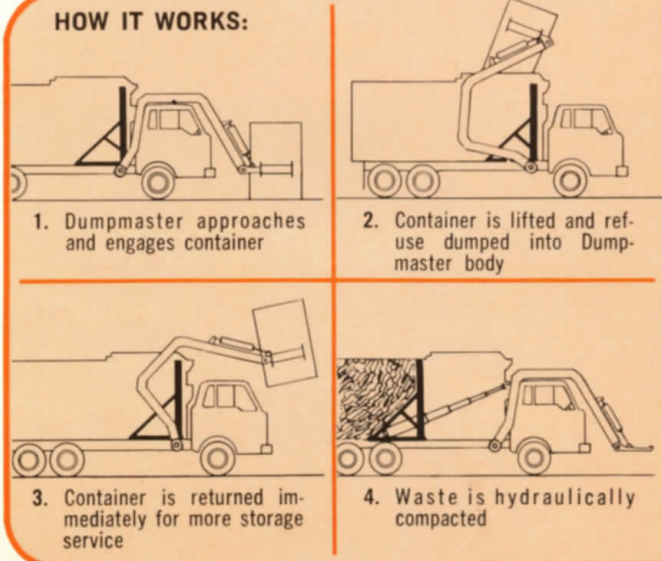


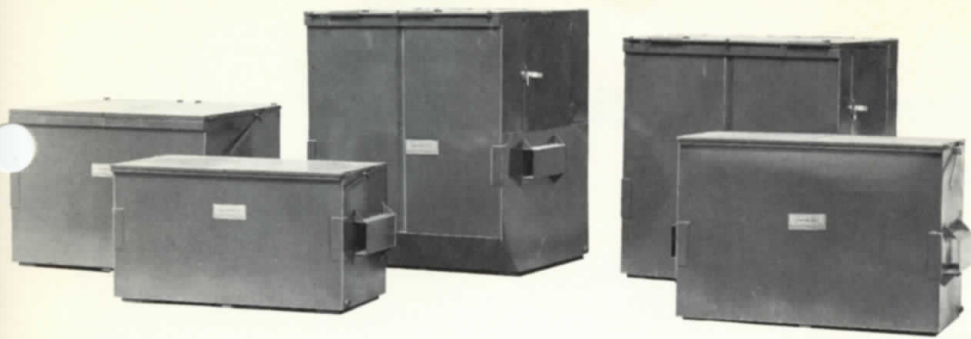

Stores Many Types of Waste

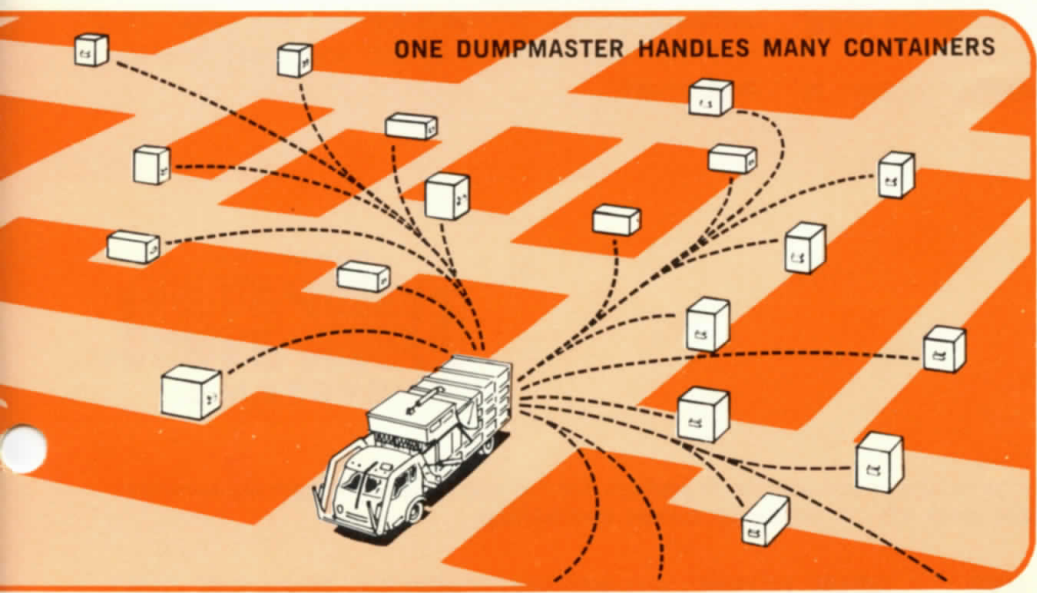

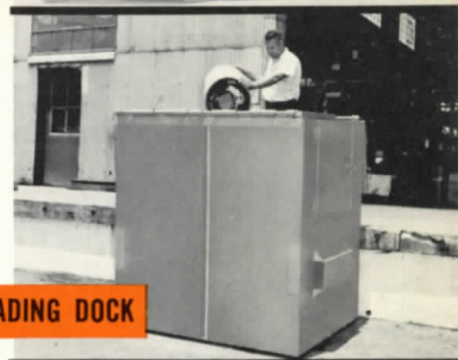
